

Charter of Champions for the Barony of Seagirt

Arts and Sciences Champion

1. The Baron and Baroness of Seagirt shall have veto rights during their tenure over any proposition brought to their Excellencies by the Champion of Arts and Sciences. This is to ensure that a Champion has at all times the best interest of the Barony and its populace. Veto rights do not incur delegation rights, only that a proposed task or plan may not be carried out.
2. The method for choosing an annual Champion shall be carried out at Seagirt Summer Tourney (SST) and shall be selected from the applicants for Arts and Sciences Champion. The selection of the Champion shall be the best of those that entered that day. Should no one enter then the position of Arts and Sciences Champion shall remain vacant until the following year when Champions will once again be selected from available applicants.
3. The Challenges for Arts and Sciences Champion shall be standardized and these shall be:
 - a. An Artistic form with supporting documentation
 - b. A Technological form with supporting documentation
 - c. Choice of one of the following (preference given to documentation but not required)
 - i. A bardic presentation
 - ii. Onsite favour making (Barony to supply materials in kit form)
4. Changes to how the challenges for Arts and Sciences Champion shall be carried out may only be made prior to The Barony of Seagirt's Daffodil Tourney. If the current Champion intends to make changes to the format then they shall discuss with the current reigning Baron and Baroness and shall make the announcement no later than the closing court of Daffodil. This is to ensure adequate time for applicants to create the necessary Arts and Sciences articles.
5. The duties of the Arts and Sciences Deputy shall be, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. To advise the Baron and Baroness and the Minister of Arts and Sciences where asked
 - b. To represent the Barony of Seagirt in Arts and Sciences
 - c. To promote Arts and Sciences for and in the Barony of Seagirt
 - d. To be an example of Chivalry, Courtesy and Gallantry
